WACDL CLE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- We award scholarships on the basis of need. In this regard, the program works on the honor system. Applicants must attest that they are financially unable to pay the program fee. Further documentation is not required.
- Scholarships may be provided both to WACDL members and to non-members.
- Each applicant may only receive one CLE Scholarship per year.
- Each scholarship is normally for 50% of the CLE registration fee for the specified program. Applicants will still be responsible for their own transportation, food, and lodging expenses. If the applicant's employer will contribute a portion of the CLE registration fee, the applicant is still eligible to receive a scholarship. The normal amount of the scholarship awarded to such an applicant, however, will be limited to 50% of the amount of the applicant's share of the fee.
- WACDL will normally award one scholarship for every 30 paid registrants. For example, should WACDL have 90 people register to attend a CLE, WACDL would have the discretion to award three scholarships to that particular program.

PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION:

- The CLE Scholarship program is overseen by WACDL's Executive Director and the WACDL CLE Committee Co-Chairs.
- Scholarship applications must be received by WACDL three weeks before the CLE program you wish to attend. Applications for a scholarship to the Annual Conference must be received by WACDL six weeks before the date of the conference.
- The executive director reviews and — as long as they fit our guidelines and don't put us over the limit — approves applications for WACDL scholarships to WACDL programs. When there are more applicants than available scholarships, or when the executive director has a question about an application, the CLE Committee co-chairs will join the executive director in reviewing applications and determining when to award scholarships. When this happens, the executive director will remove applicants' names from applications prior to sending them to the co-chairs.

PROGRAM FUNDING:

- WACDL funds with program by donations from members.
